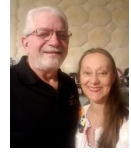
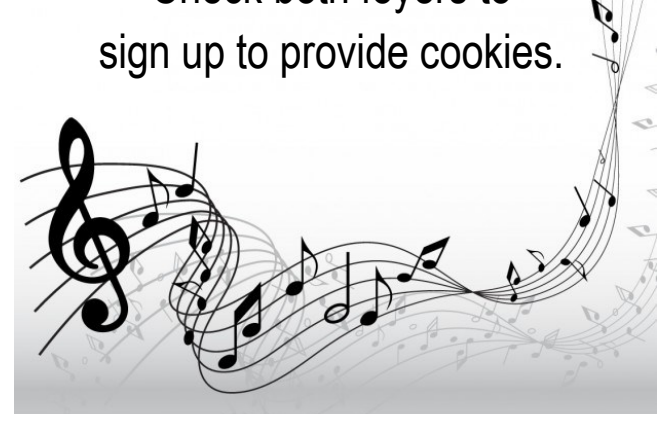

### Hear no Evil, See no Evil, Speak no Evil
