Alan Martin Marriage & "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing. If anyone does not remain in me, he is like a branch that is thrown away and withers..." (John 15:5-6).

Family Minister John Naisbitt, in his 1982 book "Megatrends 2000," predicted that the more we will connect with high tech, the more we will yearn for high touch." So true! Humans have numerous social connecting platforms via technology but more are feeling lonely, depressed, and deprived. How come? There is a simplistic, biblical explanation: "we were created to be fulfilled by human-to-human connection." God overlooked the creation of robots in Eden for Adam but instead created Eve – a live human partner with God-like senses, communicative abilities, and depth of emotions. God knew exactly what we needed way before John Naisbitt made his prediction!

Then around 4 BC, God upped *the connection level* in person... Jesus Christ (a human!) This triangulated the level of **connection** humans truly needed in life on this planet. Marriage (two people **connecting** intimately for a long time) is not enough. Human friendships (no matter how close) are not enough. Man-and-his-dog (or cat) is not enough and satisfying. Tail-gating and attending games with buddies are not enough!

But all of the above (and more) and being fully **connected** with Jesus and His body in a vital and fully devoted way – "i.e. remaining in Him and bearing fruit," will be the cure for our **connection** deficits. First, be fully **connected to HIM** and do not neglect your **connection with others!**


